2023/92 Approval of Minutes

To confirm the Minutes of the Council Meeting held 18th October 2023. The minutes were APPROVED, and it was <u>RESOLVED</u> that the minutes be signed and ADOPTED as a true record. Minutes signed by the Chairman.

2023/93 Clerks Report

- 1) Employment contract for was given to Councillors by the new Clerk to complete, with hourly wage and contractual hours agreed.
- 2) Connexus Clerk had been in contact with Connexous following the car park issues at Hints Meadow. Connexous have responded and have been sent pictures showing the areas of concern.
- 3) Veolia Clerk had received an email following a refuse collection problem at Lion Lane, Little Isle asking the Parish Council for their help. Suggestions of carrying out a PR stunt were suggested or asking the residents to form a trust or committee. Ultimately, it was decided that although the council appreciate the issue, it was up to the residents to resolve and it was not really a council matter.

2023/94 Parish Matters

- 1) Drains There are a number of drains around the parish that have been identified as dangerous, with 'teeth' missing, leaving big holes. The Clerk will contact Highways and report the issue.
- 2) Noticeboard at The Bower following a number of discussions in regards to construction and materials i.e the use of concrete posts, it was agreed that the Clerk would contact Andy to discuss the matter and options further.
- 3) The Water Pump To be added to the National Heritage List for England. There are 2 options, either to use the regular listing service, which is free but can take 6 months or to fast track, which will take 12 weeks, but for a cost of £540. It was agreed to use the regular listing service and for the clerk to start the process.
- 4) The Quarry and the wall at Clee Hill Plant. Clerk will look into progress and follow up where necessary.

Proposal: Change of use of land to residential, demolition of existing garage and erection of a carport and store – Clerk to ask for further clarification regarding the term "Change of use of land to residential"

Hints Farm, Hints, Ludlow,

Proposal: Replacement/repair of existing windows and installation of porch roofs to entrance doors – No objection, however within the application form a question had been answered incorrectly regarding whether the property could be viewed from a public footpath and/or road, the applicants had said 'no', when it should have been 'yes'.

2023/97 Bus Shelter – Vandalised

The Clerk had contacted 2 companies regarding the replacement of the front panel of the bus shelter, following vandalism. One had not responded and the other could supply but not fit. It was agreed that the Clerk would continue to research for more quotes and in the meantime contact the police for a crime reference number for insurance purposes.

The Parish Council agreed to give Coreley PCC £600 towards the maintenance of the Churchyard. Paperwork was completed and returned to the Clerk.
