## Coreley Parish Plan Review Group. (CPPRG)



In 2015 the Coreley Parish Plan was published following many months of research by a group of volunteers, at the request of the Parish Council. Those of you who lived in the village from 2012 on might remember a meeting in the Memorial Hall and subsequent views of residents obtained through the completion of questionnaires. Since 2015 the plan has been referred to by the Parish Council to determine planning applications and also help refine their communication strategy.

There have been many changes in the Parish since then, from the impact of Covid to the cost-ofliving crisis, the sad loss of neighbours in addition to the arrival of new residents. The plan has to reflect these and other more current issues and needs to be reviewed and changed to reflect our present needs. Following a request from the Parish Council a group of volunteers, including some of those involved in the 2015 plan, have formed a Review Group, the CPPRG, and started work. The group would welcome additional members, particularly from our younger residents, from businesses operating in the Parish and also from regular visitors and users of the Memorial Hall. If you think you can help, contact details are included at the end of this leaflet.

As mentioned above it is important that the plan reflects as many views as possible and to enable further research to be carried out by the CPPRG an open afternoon for all Coreley residents has been arranged for Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> July 2023 from 2pm to 4pm in the Memorial Hall. Tea and coffee will be available.

At the community afternoon, members of the review group would like to seek views on what residents want to happen in the Parish, both in the long term and short term, and about any particular concerns that people may have. After this meeting, having obtained information about the key issues, the CPPRG plans to distribute to everyone in the Parish a more targeted questionnaire. Your answers will allow the CPPRG to prepare an action plan for the Parish Council that will represent what parishioners actually want.

We want to keep everyone informed of progress and finding out the best way to do this would be a great start. On the second page of this letter you can indicate your preferred method(s) to be kept informed. We are keen to know how you obtain information about events in the Parish, so please complete the second half also. We would like to obtain your replies to this letter within two weeks. We are prepared to collect them by hand, but it would help if you can return them electronically. A member of the Parish Council is working closely with the Review Group to ensure information on progress is passed back to the Parish Council.
